The North Carolina Native Leadership Institute is a culturally tailored leadership training program offered by the UNC American Indian Center.

The NLI is implemented in two-year cycles across three intense gatherings for current and emerging Native leaders.

Participants receive a certificate from UNC Chapel Hill upon completion of the program and gain membership to the statewide NLI Network of previous Cohort graduates.
